## PRESIDENT'S NOTES

Dear Colonial Virginians,

The International Convention in Perry, GA kept all who attended quite busy. For the most part each of us went our own way attending seminars, special activities, looking at new coaches, and visiting the vendors; but some of us were able come together for our Block Party for a hot dog dinner. Thanks to our members for making the Chapter Fair and the Block Party possible. Everyone's help was appreciated. Attending the rally were: Coopers, Crowders, Deals, Deckers, Dicks, Millers, and Warrens.

Under Colonial Virginians By-Laws, Article III, Section 3, Item F states "PARTICIPATION. Participation in at least one rally each two-year period is required to maintain membership in Colonial Virginians. The Executive Board can waive this requirement on an individual basis if conditions warrant." Attendance has been kept at each rally, but due to COVID, this by-law has not been enforced in the last few years. Starting January 2023, we once again began keeping attendance for the luncheons/rallies.

We have four members to serve on the Nominating Committee for 2023 to select a slate of officers for 2024. Since this is not an appointed position, we will have to vote to elect them at a future called business meeting. The nominees are: Carol Anton, Dick Brothers, Bobby Crowder, and Ken Woolard, as an alternate.

#### The Proposals for consideration:

**Currently, Colonial Virginians By-Law, Article III, Section 1, Item C states:** 

"This chapter is open to FMCA members who own or have at least 1/3 ownership in a self-propelled, completely self-contained motorcoach that contains all the conveniences of a home, including cooking, sleeping, and permanent sanitary facilities, and in which the driver's area is directly accessible in a walking position from the living quarters."

If approved, Colonial Virginians By-Law, Article III, Section 1, Item C would read:

This chapter is open to FMCA members who own or have at least 1/3 ownership in a completely self-contained motorcoach or towable RV, which contains all the conveniences of a home, including cooking, sleeping, and permanent sanitary facilities.

Presently, The Colonial Virginians Standing Rule #3 reads:

"A rally fee is assessed by the Host and Co-host of each rally and should be used to cover any extra cost for the rallies. (August 24, 1991)"

If approved, Standing Rule #3 would read:

A rally fee is assessed by the Host and Co-host of each rally and should be used to cover any extra cost for the rally. Guests will contribute to the rally fee.

\*We will be adding another proposal to our Standing Rules:

Standing Rule 12. With the approval of the Executive Board, Colonial Virginians will pay for a Rally Room up to \$200 per rally and not to exceed \$1,000 per year with not less than 10 coaches attending a rally.

Since the items above must be announced in the Newsletter prior to a business meeting, so the members may vote to elect a Nominating Committee and to approve the changes in the By-laws and the Standing Rules, we will continue to run them in the Newsletter. At this time, I am hoping to arrange a conference call Business Meeting or a Zoom Business Meeting with our members, so we may move forward. Only those members in good standing may vote. A member in good standing must have their FMCA and Colonial Virginians dues paid for 2023. If I can make this happen, I will send a separate announcement.


