Apple Pudding Recipe from the Dogwood Acres Rally

IN A LARGE GLASS BOWL(10 INCH ROUND):



PUT OUT 1 WHOLE STICK OF BUTTER OUT TO SOFTEN.

CORE, PEEL AND WEDGE **10 GRANNY SMITH APPLES (**OTHER BAKING AP-PLES CAN BE USED BUT I HAVE FOUND THE GRANNYS THE BEST)

WHEN DONE PUT IN 1/2 CUP OF WATER AND COVER WITH CINNAMON.

IN SECOND BOWL PUT **SOFT BUTTER, 1 CUP SUGAR, 3/4 CUP FLOUR** AND USE A PASTRY CUTTER TO MAKE "CRUMBS" WITH THESE THREE INGRE-DIENTS. THIS YOU WILL SPOON OVER THE TOP OF THE APPLES AND RE-SPRINKLE WITH CINNAMON AS YOU WISH.

IT WILL BAKE FOR 1 HOUR @ 350.
