- Important date to remember: **January 1, 2024**. Must reserve your site by then if you want to be with the group and receive the group rate. After January 1st, the campground will be releasing any remaining sites of the 15 sites we have reserved.
- Sites: We have reserved 9 Premium pull-thru sites (302-318) and 6 Deluxe back-in sites (305-317). The Sonnessas will be on site 318 and the Pittmans will be on site 316.
