Close to 1,000 RVs were in attendance, with 35% of attendees being first timers and 50% of attendees who were chapter members. Activities for chapters included the Driven to Care Silent Auction (1), Chapter Fair (2), Chapter Block Parties (3), Chapter Fest, and the "La Puesta Del Sol" Parade (4). The Eastern Area donated a gift basket for the Silent Auction and helped raise \$135.

The Chapter Fair was well attended, but, unfortunately, there weren't a lot of folks attending from our nine-



state area. Having said that, Brad a Betty Brown with the Elizabeth River Going Strong (E.R.G.S.) chapter recruited a new member at the Fair. Saturday evening after the parade was the "Don't Let The Sun Go Down" Chapter Fest with Mariachi Nuevo Azteca.




April 16-18 Eric and I, along with Sue and Gary Cipa and Clarissa and Larry Sherrow, attended the Penn


